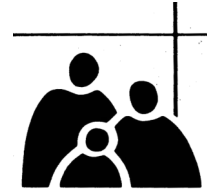


Did you know that the church was rebuilt after a devastating storm in April of 1908. On April 24th, 1910 the new brick build was dedicated. May God continue to bless our church family.
